

Special Requirements for Bodywork Practitioners to be registered on the WABA registry as a professional Watsu India - WABA Watsu Practitioner (2020)

Certified practitioners in any type of bodywork with minimum 500 hours of recognized training with the required qualifications (see below) will be recognized worldwide as Watsu practitioner as soon as all requirements listed in level 1, 2 and 3 are fulfilled.

Watsu 1	⇒ Watsu 1 (Transition Flow)	34
	Recommended: give minimum 5 sessions after Watsu 1 (not more than 3 to the same person/receiver)	
	Recommended: receive minimum 2 sessions from a certified Watsu practitioner	
Level	⇒ Watsu 2 (Expanded Flow)	50
Watsu 2	⇒ Shiatsu for Watsu (or equivalent land course)	50
	⇒ Demonstration of mastery of Watsu 2 to a recognized WABA instructor before applying for Watsu 3	2
	Recommended: give minimum 10 sessions between Watsu 2 and Watsu 3 (not more than 3 to the same person/receiver)	
	Recommended: receive minimum 5 sessions from a certified Watsu practitioner	
Level	⇒ Audit (repeat) Watsu 2 and/or WABA electives	50
Watsu 3	⇒ Watsu 3	50
	⇒ Watsu Special Integration (only if suggested by your tutor)	n/a
	⇒ Hands-on session to a recognized WABA instructor after Watsu 3	2
	⇒ Total logged sessions given during training period: minimum 20 (not more than 3 to the same person/receiver)	
	⇒ Total logged sessions received during training period: minimum 10 from a certified Watsu practitioner	
	⇒ Provide Basic Life Support (CPR) certificate

Continuing training:

After completing the certification process, 50 hours of training is required every 3 years to keep the practitioner status valid.
